### **HS2 (40 minutes)**

*Groundwork - An Environmental/Community charity - administers two funds t on behalf of HS2 Ltd. The funds are available to local communities to help with the disruption that will be caused by the construction of Phase one of HS2 between London and the West Midlands.*
